Description

Lee County is in the process of developing a countywide GIS database and needs assistance with this task. The intern's primary responsibility will be analyzing data, and creating and updating GIS layers, specifically utilities (public water and sewer lines). Participation in planning commission meetings and attendance at County Commission meetings will provide professional opportunities and experience. The county will provide additional training on GIS software, and local government practice and planning functions, as part of the internship.

Qualifications

Intern candidates should have the ability to work with ESRI ArcGIS Desktop to perform data conversion/editing, spatial database management and map production, have strong attention to detail and tolerance for data focused tasks, have a valid driver's license and good driving record, and exhibit organizational, teamwork and project management skills. Preference will be given to students pursuing a degree in geography, science, planning, GIS or related field. The intern project will involve the creation of utilities (public water and sewer) layers utilizing coordinate geometry (COGO).
