Renewal Instructions for 2025 Business Licenses

"On behalf of your Lee County Commissioners, Thank You for **Your Investment in Lee County." Please find enclo**sed an application for your 2025 Lee County Business License Renewal. Please fill out all required information and return to this office with the appropriate fees enclosed.

If your primary license is in another county then you <u>MUST</u> send a copy of that license with the application for renewal, the fee will be \$37.50. If you are licensed by the state you <u>MUST</u> send a copy of your state license along with your primary license. <u>FOR THOSE STATE LICENSEES THAT HOLD</u> <u>THEIR PRIMARY LICENSE IN OTHER THAN LEE COUNTY</u> <u>THERE WILL BE NOFEE, FOR THOSE STATE LICENSEES THAT</u> <u>HOLD THEIR PRIMARY LICENSE IN LEE COUNTY THE ONLY</u> <u>FEE REQUIRED IS THE OCCUPATIONAL TAX</u>

A penalty of \$50.00 is imposed on each business that fails to renew by January 15, 2025. When fees remain unpaid beyond thirty (30) days from the due date the penalty shall be \$100.00.

<u>If you do not plan to resume business within Lee County in</u> 2025, it is your responsibility to notify this office in writing so that we can remove your business from our list of active businesses. Please do not hesitate to do this as it could result in other penalties that may be applicable in conjunction with your business license renewal.

When reviewed and approved, your business license will be mailed to you.

- Please fill out the business license application completely and return it with the appropriate fees.
- If your primary license is in other than Lee County then you must send a copy of that primary license with the completed application and the fee will be \$37.50, unless you are licensed by the state in which case there would be no fee.
- *If* you are licensed by the state you must send a copy of your state license along with a copy of your primary license and completed application. Licensees that hold

- If you do not plan to resume business within Lee County in 2025, it is your responsibility to notify this office in writing so we may remove your business from our list of active businesses.
- A penalty of \$50.00 is imposed on each business that fails to renew by January 15th, 2025.
- A penalty of \$100.00 shall be imposed on each business that fails to renew by January 31st, 2025.
- Penalties shall be in addition to any other penalties that may be applicable in conjunction with non-renewal of your business license.
- Failure to renew your Lee County License or notify this office of non renewal may result in legal action per code section 62-191 of the Lee County Code of Ordinances.
- <u>All Lee County Business Licenses will expire December 31, 2024.</u>

1. Occupation Tax:

For the calendar year beginning January 1, 1995, and succeeding years thereafter, if you are engaged in any business, trade profession, or occupation in Lee County, Georgia, whether with a location in the unincorporated areas of Lee County or in the case of an out-of-state business with no location in Georgia exerting substantial efforts within the state pursuant of O.C.G.A. 48-19-7, you must pay an occupation tax for said business, trade, profession, or occupation. The tax is based upon your number of employees. (A separate return should be filled for each business location.)

II. Administrative Fee

III. Any person who shall operate or conduct any business, profession, trade, or occupation listed below must pay the annual regulatory fee as allowed under O.C.G.A. 48-13-9 on those applicable businesses. The regulatory fee shall be in addition to any occupation tax or administrative fee imposed upon such business, trade, or occupation.

The regulatory fee in the amount of (\$37.50) is hereby imposed as authorized under O.C.GA. S48-13-9. Such regulatory fee shall apply to each business listed as follows.

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Dear Business Owner:

After many years of negotiation and after conducting a test program, the Georgia Department of Revenue has implemented a program to collect and exchange information with local governments in regard to sales and use tax identification numbers as assigned by the Georgia Department of Revenue. Use of these data will help assure that tax collections by the state are properly recorded and properly distributed to Lee County. Conversely, the municipality will be able to verify occupational tax data on file with the state.

In accordance with Georgia Code **48-13-20.1**, "each municipality or county must request the sales and use tax identification number assigned to such business..." For further information on this requirement, go to <u>www.dor.ga.gov</u> or call <u>877-423-6711</u>

In the past, Lee County has not asked for this information. However, in order to take advantage of this new program, it becomes necessary to collect the sales and use tax identification number that was issued to you by the state.

OCCUPATIONAL TAX CERTIFICATE HOME OCCUPATION AFFIDAVIT

Article I – Lee County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 70 – Zoning, Sec. 70-6 Definitions

Home occupation: Any use conducted entirely within the dwelling and carried on by the inhabitants thereof, which use is incidental and secondary to the use of the dwelling for dwelling purposes and does not change the character thereof. Provided further, that no article or service is sold or offered for sale on the premises, except such as is produced, sold, or provided to customers in connection with such occupation; that such occupation shall not require internal or external alterations or construction, open storage or signs not customary in residential areas. One non-illuminated name plate, which is not more than two square feet in area, may be attached to the building which shall contain only the name and occupation of the resident of the premises. Clinics, hospitals, childcare centers, and day nurseries, among others, shall not be deemed to be home occupations.

Home occupation, residential:

(1) The home occupation use shall only be allowed in residential zoning districts which allow home occupations.

(2) The dwelling unit must maintain a residential appearance and there shall be no outward evidence of the occupation or impacts in appearance, noise, light, odor, traffic and utilities that would be detectable beyond the dwelling unit.
(3) The use shall be conducted entirely within the dwelling unit and accessory structures with not more than 25 percent of the property's gross floor area devoted to the home occupation.

(4) No more than one home occupation shall be authorized for any residential dwelling unit.

(5) No business materials or equipment shall be stored at the premises of the home occupation unless such material or equipment is stored in an area within the residence. No business vehicles used in the home occupation shall be stored on the premises where the home occupation is undertaken.

(6) The following businesses, uses, and activities shall be prohibited as home occupation uses: adult entertainment establishments; kennels; stables; veterinarian clinics; medical and dental clinics; restaurants, clubs, and drinking establishments; motor vehicle repair or small engine repair; funeral parlors; adult businesses; limousine service; taxi service; and wrecker service.

(7) Motor vehicles of customers of the person conducting the home occupation may be parked at the premises of the home occupation during business hours while the customer is conducting business with the person operating the home occupation. No provision of this subsection shall be construed to authorize a violation of either restrictive covenants applicable to the premises where the home occupation is being conducted or to amend any provision of the County's Code of Ordinances with respect to the types of motor vehicles which may be parked in a residential subdivision.
(8) Non-conforming home occupation uses: Non-conforming uses permitted as of October 1, 2005, shall be allowed to continue to operate under the following conditions:

a. No non-conforming use may be changed to another non-conforming use.

b. No non-conforming use shall be increased, extended or enlarged beyond the size or scope of the use as it existed on the date of issuance of the current occupation tax certificate.

c. The non-conforming use is specially designated to the current property and business owner. (The home occupational use is not transferable.)

d. Violation of these conditions will result in an immediate and permanent revocation of the right to continue the nonconforming use.
